4. Finance – Jean Swary
  - a. More diocesan assessments are being placed on local parish budgets, beginning July 1, which is causing a financial strain.
  - b. Motion to approve budget by Jan Wenzinger, second by Denise Swary.
5. Maintenance – Tom Thomas
  - a. Lee Construction gave a \$11,000 bid to paint and refurbish four louvers and the round window on the church bell tower.
  - b. Add metal shield to south louver to prevent moisture problem in the tower.
  - c. Suggested the new church carpet be cleaned. Denise Swary will check with ServiceMaster for a bid.
6. Jean Swary asked for nominations for money counters to place on the ballots. It was the consensus by Council that no new members were needed until next year.
7. Tom Mutchler suggested that the following items be addressed in the bulletin:
  - a. Purchase of a new lawnmower at \$6,000
  - b. Mausoleum electric run at \$2,200
  - c. Mausoleum roof replacement at \$22,000
  - d. Church microphone repair at \$5,000
  - e. Refurbish bell tower louvers and round window at \$11,000
8. Chicken Barbecue
  - a. Jan Wenzinger volunteered to order 350 chicken halves for meals and 75 halves for chicken only from Holgate County Pride.
  - b. Jan Wenzinger will order potato salad from Holgate County Pride.
  - c. Jan Wenzinger purchased dinner rolls from Lynne Niese, who will donate butter.
  - d. Workers will be needed the day of the chicken barbecue.
  - e. Tom Thomas will place the sign at the corner and make sure the drive is blocked for access to the school kitchen.
