A. Committee Reports

2. Adult Education

4. Finance – Jean Swary
  - a. Council members reviewed October financial report and July thru October financial report.
  - b. Jean stated the fuel bill was paid but diocesan assessment was still not paid.
  - c. Jean stated that this bill would be addressed after Christmas.

  - f. Tom Thomas stated that plumbing issues due to age might prevent major renovation.
  - g. Tom Thomas will look into at least widening the stall.
